# RED WINE

## CABERNET SAUVIGNON

Cabernet Sauvignon is often referred to as the “King of Red Wine Grapes” originally from Bordeaux. Cabs range from medium-bodied to full-bodied and are characterized by their high tannin content which serves to provide structure and intrigue while supporting the rich fruit characteristics.

## PINOT NOIR

Pinot Noir may be the toughest grape to grow but the effort is often well worth the constant care and investment. As for style Pinot Noir is typically a lighter-bodied fruit-forward red wine. Its flavors are reminiscent of sweet red berries| plums| cherries and at times a notable earthy or wood-like flavor.
